Thank you for offering to support some of the families in our communities.

This family consists of a single mother and her five children (3 sons and 2 daughters). This family identifies as black with heritage being from Africa. One of the daughters is hard of hearing and wears a hearing aid. She suffers from anxiety and depression. Despite her challenging circumstances, her goal is to finish all of her high school credits so she can receive her diploma and get a job to help her family. Her older sister is a big support and advocates for her sister to receive services in the community.

The family is requesting warm winter clothing for everyone. This includes coats, hats, scarves, mittens, sweaters, etc.

Mom – She wears shoe size 8-9 and is 2XL in clothing.

**Boy, age 7** – He wears **shoe size 4.5** and his **clothing size is medium**.

Boy, age 11 – He wears shoe size 5 and his clothing size is medium.

Boy, age 17 – He wears shoe size 10 and his clothing size is medium.

<u>Girl, age 19</u> – She is size small-medium, likes black, purple and pink. She typically wears things like jeans, dress pants, long sleeve dress shirts, and sweaters. She feels comfortable dressing more conservatively. This student identifies as Muslim so any special cloth like chiffon, silk, or cotton is appreciated, so that she can use to cover her hair. She also needs shampoo, conditioner, always overnight pads, deodorant, body wash, toothbrush, floss, winter boots, jeans, sweatpants, socks, and a winter scarf the most.

<u>Girl, age 27</u> – her shoe size is 10 and her clothing size is large.

As a whole, the family likes to shop at Walmart, Dollarama, No Frills, and Winners.
