Thank you for offering to support some of the families in our communities.

This family consists of a single mother and her 3 children. This family identifies as black. They are low income and any help they can get is highly appreciated. The mom is very lovely and supportive to her children and has been very proactive about their mental health and well being. Her youngest child is in grade 3 and has been recently diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder. Her other son who is in Grade 4 also has an Autism Spectrum Disorder diagnosis. Both her boys are very active and love to run around and play with their toys. The eldest child is a 13 year old girl in grade 8.

<u>Boy, age 8</u> – he needs **clothing (size 7-8 or size medium)** and his favourite colour is green. He needs **winter boots (size 3)** Due to his diagnoses, he loves **fidget toys** and any other toys that can help him manage his impulses, like stress balls, squish mellows, etc.

<u>Boy, age 9</u> – he needs **clothing (size 9-10 or size medium)** and his favourite colour is red. He also needs **winter boots (size 4)**. He also appreciates things like **fidget toys, toy cars, games,** etc.

<u>Girl, age 13 years</u> – she needs **clothing (size 14 or size large)** and her favourite colour is purple. She also needs **winter boots (size 8)**. As the only female sibling, she appreciates things like **accessories**, **jewellery**, **nail polish**, **etc.**

<u>Mom</u> – she needs **clothing** (size XL). The family likes to shop at **Walmart**, **No Frills**, **Winners**, **Toys R Us**, **Dollarama**.
