This is a family consisting of a single mother, her 3 children and her nephew. Mum is focused on the well-being and success of all four children. She is involved in all aspects of their schooling needs and is in regular contact with their teachers, working with them on routines and the expectations of home and school. One of her sons has ASD and she therefore has to focus more time on his emotional development. Each day there are conversations and learning how to respond and cope in social situations with family, classmates and in the community.

Her oldest child, her **son is 12 years old** and is identified with Autism (ASD). He is a grade 7 student and attends an intense support program for students with ASD. His mum reports he enjoys playing Roblox and other online games. He also enjoys reading mystery stories and likes to draw as well. He wears size 14-18 for any clothing or pj's.

Her oldest **daughter is 9 ½ years** old in grade 4. Her mum reports her daughter enjoys arts and crafts from drawing, painting, and making items. She wears a size 14-18 as she is a tall girl.

Her nephew is **5 years old in SK**. He enjoys anything with wheels. He loves his cars and trucks. He wears a size 5 for any pj's or clothing.

The youngest **daughter is 2 years old**. She enjoys her baby dolls and stuffed animals. She wears a size 2T for any pj's or clothes.

For mum, she would appreciate any toiletries, body lotion and scented candles. She also shops at Walmart.

The family could use a supply of toiletries and body lotion for everyone.
